Message from Hot Springs County School District Superintendent, Mr. Kobza:

This is just a reminder to everyone that we have several students in each of our buildings that have severe peanut/tree nut allergies. These allergies kill. It is extremely important that you communicate with your students when snacks or meals are being brought to school. No peanuts or peanut products should be included even if you do not have a student with the allergy in your classroom. Contact of any kind can cause a severe reaction for an effected student. This is truly a life and death situation. Thank you for your help.

We know that many parents like to celebrate birthdays and other occasions with special treats. We encourage parents to celebrate with non-food items such as stickers, pencils, themed erasers, or other trinkets, rather than food. Any homemade food items should be peanut-free.

Things kids can do: (www.foodallergy.org)

1. Food allergies are serious. Don't make jokes about them.
2. Don't share food with friends who have food allergies.
3. Wash your hands after eating.
4. Ask what your friends are allergic to, and help them avoid it.
5. If a friend who has food allergies becomes ill, get help immediately!
