This program is coordinated by Cody McLean, School Counselor and Kevin Simpson, Kindergarten teacher.

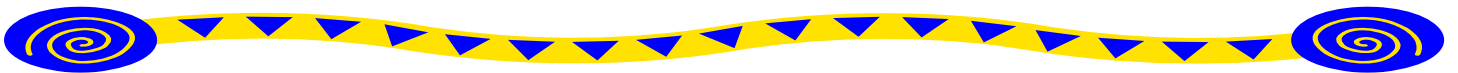

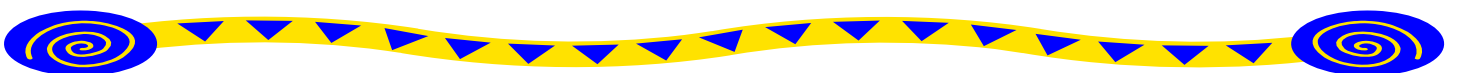


Announcing!!!
